## ADULT SOFTBALL <br> LEAGUE RULES

## ROSTERS/LINEUPS:

-ALL players must be registered online to be eligible for the season.
-NO PLAYER FEE. Just need players to sign a waiver to be eligible.
-Registration must be done online.
-Players that are not on your roster will not be eligible for regular season games or playoffs
-Rosters must consist of a minimum of 9 players
-7 men/ 3 women (Can play 6 men 3 woman with no out)
-ALL Co-Ed Teams must have a minimum of 3 women on roster.
-Players must play in 50\% of regular season games to be eligible for the playoffs

## SCHEDULE: TBD

Men's A: Mondays
Church: Tuesdays
CoEd: Wednesdays
Men's B: Thursdays
-Start time of games will be 6:30/7:30/8:30pm
-There will be no time allowance for late arrivals
-12 game regular season

## MAKE-UPS/CANCELLATIONS:

-Make up games will be played on the same day of the week as your regular league games (OTHER THAN CoEd) -Make up days may be Friday evenings OR Sunday afternoons.
-Make up dates will not be changed due to outside commitments of players.
-Other tournaments, concerts, events, etc.
-If games are not able to be made up, they will be pushed to the end of the season
-IF NEEDED we will host a "make up day" to finish as many make up games as needed

## FORFEITS

-ALL teams that need to forfeit a game must do so by emailing or calling the Bangor Parks and Recreation

-Forfeits will count as a win for the other team
-ALL forfeits must be called in by 4:30pm on the day of the game.
-Any team that forfeits 3 or more games may be subject to removal from the playoffs- no refunds
-No call forfeit = 2 forfeits

## SCORING

$-20,15,10$ run rule: The game is over and won by the team that is leading by $10+$ runs after 5 innings, $15+$ runs after 4 innings or $20+$ runs after 3 innings.

## GAMEPLAY RULES

-No Base stealing
-Home run limit: Ladder Rule 4:1

## EQUIPMENT

-All equipment needs to match the ASA standards

- TEAMS ARE REQUIRED TO RETRIEVE ALL HOME RUN BALLS
-No metal spikes on cleats


## PLAYOFFS:

-ALL teams make the playoffs
-Playoff seeding is decided by end of regular season records
-Teams will compete in a double elimination playoff format

## EJECTIONS/SUSPENSIONS

-Any player ejected from a game will serve a ONE WEEK suspension from the league
-If suspended on a Monday, you will serve your suspension the following Monday
-If you play in two leagues, your suspension will carry into all leagues.
-2 ejections = possible removal from the league. No refunds.
-ANY threats or physical violence will result in immediate removal from the league. No refunds.
-ALL ejections will be reviewed by the Umpire in Charge, as well as the Bangor Parks and Recreation
-ALL ejections are subject to an appeal process
-Eye witness accounts will be asked for and recorded by members of both teams for review

## CAPTAIN/COACH EXPECTATIONS

-Coaches/Captains are expected to be the point of contact for their represented teams.
-Relay information from the Parks and Recreation to your team if needed
-Ensure players are registered (no player fee) so that they are eligible for the season
-Announce any forfeits or cancellations to the Parks and Recreation
-Ensure that all players are adhering to the rules and policies of the Parks and Recreation

## PARKS AND RECREATION RESPONSIBILITIES

-Ensure fields/facilities are ready for all games
-Ensure games are covered by officials
-Provide softballs for the start of the season
-Provide scorebooks for teams as requested
-Schedule regular season/post season and makeup games

## DRUGS/ALCOHOL

The use of drugs and alcohol is prohibited at the fields and on city property

## REGISTRATION/LEAGUE DUES:

-Team fee =\$750
-\$25 down payment due at registration
-\$350 DUE by April ${ }^{\text {st, }} 2024$
-\$375 or remaining balance DUE by May 1 ${ }^{\text {st }}, 2024$
