

The Bangor Parks and Recreation Department is committed to keeping participants, guests and staff safe during these unprecedented times as we deal with the Covid-19. To ensure the safety for all, the guidelines below must be followed during any use of our facilities.

## For indoor activities and programs:

- ➤ Participants, guests, and any others agree NOT to enter the Parks and Recreation Center or any indoor facility if they have symptoms or exposure risks listed by the CDC guidelines.
- Face coverings must be worn to enter any indoor facility.
- ➤ Face covering must be worn at all times when in our facilities including practices, competitions, and other programs taking place.
  - o Face coverings can be removed for eating and drinking.
    - Eating and drinking should take place in one area and not moving about the room or building.
- Numbers may limited to how may participate or attend depending on which facility is being usesed.
  - o **Effective March 26, 2021 through May 23, 2021:** 50% of permitted occupancy or 50 persons, whichever is greater.
  - Effective May 24, 2021 and thereafter: 75% of permitted occupancy or 50 persons, whichever is greater.
- > Every attempt is made to clean and disinfect any touch points after use.
- ➤ Hand sanitizer is available throughout the facility.

## For outdoor activities and programs:

- ➤ Participants, guests, and any others agree NOT to attend or participate if they have symptoms or exposure risks listed by the CDC guidelines.
- Face coverings do not have to worn when attending or participating at our outdoor facilities.
  - o Must wear face coverings if social distancing is not possible. Such as below.
    - Huddling up during team events
    - Athletes on the bench.
    - If entering locker rooms or restrooms together.
    - Fans standing near or with other fans from outside their family.
    - Coaches, scorekeepers, etc. if not distanced from others
- Numbers may limited to how may participate or attend depending on which outdoor facility is being used.
  - o Effective March 26, 2021 through May 23, 2021: 75% of permitted occupancy.
  - o Effective May 24, 2021 and thereafter: 100% of permitted occupancy.
- > Every attempt is made to clean and disinfect any touch points after use.
- Although hand sanitizer is available at many of our outdoor facilities, we ask that you bring your own if possible as it may not be close to use on a regular basis.

All procedures and guidelines are subject to change as we as a department monitor and follow CDC recommendations.
